Parking and Security Etiquette

Security Procedure Reminders

The Board is aware that we have had a few issues involving residents, guests and vendors not wanting to follow the rules in place for access into the community with Security. These rules have been put in place for the overall safety of everyone in the community and it is expected to be followed without exception! Please review the requirements for access below and review with all your guests, vendors and tenants:

- All vehicles that request access MUST show a VALID driver's license. The license will be scanned at Security - the scan simply shows if the license is valid or not. Anyone without a license to present at Security will be DENIED.
- If a homeowner forgets their driver's license, the Homeowner will be able to show a copy of their current vehicle registration, and if the registration has a address within Calabay, you can be granted access as a courtesy, but you will still be required to have your license next time.
- Full-time residents and Homeowners can also apply and recieve decals to place in their car to expedite entry through Security. Decals are only for Homeowners and Full-Time Residents of the Community. If you need to get a decal, please find the application below.

SMILE! You're on Camera!

As a reminder, the HOA has Security Cameras positioned in many areas around Security to monitor activity, which records both visual and audio. The HOA will not tolerate aggressive or violent outbursts from ANYONE towards Security Personnel. Any harassment of security or ANY HOA vendor will be reviewed and handled as required with the recorded incident being sent to any authority the Board deems appropriate.
